First visited by white men August 14, 1909.

As early as 1907 a Navajo, Ushinibenaethin, told Mrs. John Hetherill that there was a great stone arch over in one of the canyons near Navajo Mountain. But Ushinibenaethin did not take Mr. Hetherill to it. Then in the spring of 1909 Noschaw and Noschawbigay, Pahutes from near Navajo Mountain told Mrs. Hetherill that they had seen the big arch north-west of Navajo Mountain in Nonnezoshie Boko (Arch Canyon). Noschawbigay then promised to guide Mr. Hetherill and Professor Cummings to the arch when the Utah party should return to the country in June, 1909. Professor Cummings and his party of students were working in Sage Canyon, waiting for Mr. Hetherill to make the trip to Navajo Mt. in search of the arch. Mr. Hetherill came to the Sage for the trip, but brought letters stating that Mr. H. B. Douglass, an inspector of surveys for the U. S. government, was at Bluff endeavoring to have the permits of the Utah party cancelled, and that he would be at Ogata in three days on his way to Navajo Mt., also in quest of the big arch of which he had learned the winter before from Mrs. Hetherill. In order to be a representative of the U. S. government and to find out why he was endeavoring to stop the explorations of the Utah party, Mr. Cummings and Mr. Hetherill turned back to Ogata to meet Mr. Douglass and join forces in quest of the arch. On reaching Pahute canyon Noschawbigay was away on the mesa with his sheep, but his father went for him and he met the party beyond the slick rocks, but that night he then led the party to the arch, although Mr. Douglass had urged both parties to return to their homes, but there was no use of going on and so they should go on.

^{the} ~~the~~ ^{young} Pahute from Pahute canyon, was the official guide of the party and the only man who knew the location of the arch. He died in the winter of 1917-18. Professor Cummings is the best authority on the location of this great natural wonder and Mrs. John Hetherill first found under its ground. These facts can be verified from any one of the several men accompanying the party.



THE CLEVELAND PLAIN DEALER SECOND EXPEDITION

Sighting out after 10 days at Rainbow Bridge

Every member of the expedition has made the trip from Rainbow Lodge on foot twice, carrying heavy packs. Our pedant says it is 10 3/4 miles. Our count of steps gives 28,000. Our estimate of distance is 11 miles. Lillick walked out to the lodge in 6 hrs by moonlight. Parks walked in with 25 pound pack and portable typewriter in 5 hrs 5 min. We cut 30 steps in cliff next to bridge above to facilitate getting on top. We call this 40 feet of steps The Plain Dealer Trail. It was finished Sept. 14. It can be used without ropes but we advise against this until steps can be cut deeper. We leave here with sincere regret that our stay is not longer.
